The COVID-19 pandemic brings a lot of uncertainty and challenges for all of us. Information is rapidly changing, and we are doing our best to keep all of our families safe and healthy.

Brigid's Path will remain open and actively supporting the needs of our babies and their families.

As a licensed Children's Crisis Care Facility for the state of Ohio, we focus on serving families impacted by addiction during our normal operations. But, we can also help babies and moms who are in crisis for other reasons.

We have private nurseries available for babies if they can't be discharged home, or if mom and baby don't have a safe place to go because of this crisis.

Until the state of emergency declaration is lifted, changes to our procedures include:

- **Staff/Volunteers** – Special screening protocol enacted before entering the facility.
- **Meetings/Tours** – All groups or individuals coming in for tours or meetings are CANCELLED.
- **Travel** – All nonessential travel (conferences, meetings, etc.) has been CANCELLED.
- **In-kind Donations** – We are accepting donations at the front door by appointment only. Please call 937.350.1785 to schedule an appointment.

Our clinical leaders will continue to evaluate federal, state, and community wide policies and restrictions and make adjustments to our operations as necessary.
