
In a year filled with so many challenges for our community, it has been powerful to witness the impact that we have achieved as we showed up every day to do this HARD and HOLY work.

In 2021, our fourth year of operation, we saw so many blessings including:

- Helping 81 percent of babies served to stay with family by wrapping services, advocacy and support around them
- Hosting our most successful fundraising event ever with GROW in May 2021
- Reducing the medications our babies need while increasing our ability to care for babies with increasingly complex medical needs
- Ending the year with our busiest quarter ever in the nurseries all while continuing to navigate the pandemic

From our start, God called us to build a better way to care for babies and their families impacted by addiction. We are so proud of our work in 2021 and know we will continue to be grounded in faith as we build a greater community for the families that we serve.

#### **OUTCOMES BORN OF FAITH**

In our fourth year of caring for babies and families, we saw so many lives touched by transformation, new beginnings and hope. 


## JOURNEYS BORN OF Faith



Regardless of what you do for Brigid's Path, we are grateful for all you do.




